- □ THE PURITAN CONFLICT; WEST-MINSTER CONFESSION; CROMWELL; RESTORATION OF THE STUARTS & THE "GLORIUS REVOLUTION"
- □ THE PURITAN CONFLICT:
 - CHARLES I BECOMES KING (1625):
 - APPOINTS WILLIAM LAUD AS ARCHBISHOP
 - CHARLES ANTAGONIZES PURITAN CONFLICT:
 - ABOLISHES PARLIAMENT FOR 11 YEARS
 - CHARLES "IMPELLED BY INCURABLE PROPENSITY TO DARK & CROOKED WAYS"
 - MANY PURITANS SEEK REFUGE IN AMERICA
 - LAUD LOOKED AFTER EVERY APPOINTMENT & EVERY EXECUTIVE DETAIL IN CHURCH & STATE

□ THE PURITAN CONFLICT (CONT):

- · LAUD (CONT):
 - HIGH-CHURCH EPISCOPALIAN & ARMINIAN:
 - FILLED ALL CHURCH VACANCIES WITH "HIGH CHURCHMEN" & ARMINIANS
 - EXPELLED OR SILENCED THE PURITANS & SHUT UP EVERY UNAUTHORIZED MEETING HOUSE
 - PURITANS WERE A "MISERABLE FACTION" WHICH MUST BE CRUSHED AT ANY PRICE
 - IMPLEMENTED "STAR-CHAMBER" & HIGH COMMISSION COURT:
 - FREEDOM OF SPEECH PUNISHED AS CRIME AGAINST SOCIETY
 - UNLIMITED JURISDICTION & POWER TO INFLICT PENALITIES
 - DEPRIVATION, IMPRISONMENT, FINES, WHIPPING, BRANDING, CUTTING EARS, & SLITTING NOSES

□ THE PURITAN CONFLICT (CONT):

- REVOLT BEGINS IN SCOTLAND:
 - AUTOCRATIC "RE-ANGLICANIZATION" OF SCOTTISH CHURCH
 - NEW CHURCH GOVT, LITURGY, & PRAYER BOOK FORCED UPON SCOTS
 - SCOTS FORM NATL COVENANT (1638)
 - ENGLISH "LONG PARLIAMENT" CONVENES (1640)
 - SCOTS & ENGLISH PARLIAMENT FORM "SOLEMN LEAGUE & COVENANT" TO OVERTHROW CHARLES
 - WESTMINSTER ASSEMBLY CONVENED (1643)

□ WESTMINSTER ASSEMBLY (1643-49):

- CONVENTION OF 54 ENGLISH CHURCHMEN & SCOTTISH COMMISSIONERS

□ WESTMINSTER ASSEMBLY (CONT):

- FORM OF PRESBYTERIAL CHURCH GOVT & DIRECTORY OF PUBLIC WORSHIP (1644)
- CONFESSION OF FAITH, LARGER, SHORTER CATECHISM (1647):
 - SCOTTISH GENERAL ASSEMBLY IMMEDIATELY ADOPTS WESTMINSTER STANDARDS
 - SHORT ENGLISH PRESBYTERIAN STINT OVERTURNED BY CROMWELL & "INDEPENDENTS"

□ THE WESTMINSTER CONFESSION:

- THIRTY-THREE ARTICLES:
 - HIGHLY CALVINISTIC DOCUMENT:
 - SCRIPTURES, GOD'S NATURE, FALL OF MAN, COVENANTS, NATURE OF JUSTIFICATION & SANCTIFICATION, THE CHURCH, SACRAMENTS, MAGISTRATES, ESCHATOLOGY, ETC.
 - SPECIFIES PRESBYTERIAN FORM OF GOVT

□ OLIVER CROMWELL & THE CIVIL WAR:

- WAR BREAKS OUT BETWEEN PARLIAMENT & CHARLES (1642):
 - STAR-CHAMBER & HIGH-COMMISSION OVERTURNED (1642)
 - CROMWELL FORMS "HOLY ARMY"
 - NO OATHS, DRUNKENNESS, GAMBLING, RESPECT OF PROPERTY, WOMEN, PRAYER & PSALM SINGING IN BATTLE
 - CROMWELL'S MILITARY REIGN BEGINS (1649)
 - LAUD & CHARLES EXECUTED (1645 & 1649)
 - EXECUTIONS HORRIFY SCOTS & BRITS
- CROMWELL TURNS AGAINST PRESBYTERIANS & ALIGNS WITH INDEPENDENTS:
 - EXCLUDES PRESBYTERIANS FROM PARLIAMENT
 - CRUSHES THE SCOTS AT WORCESTER (1651)
 - DISBANDS GENERAL ASSEMBLY (1653)

□ OLIVER CROMWELL & THE CIVIL WAR:

- CROMWELL DIES (1658)
 - SUCCEEDED BY SON, RICHARD
 - CANNOT CONTROL FRAGMENTING ARMY
 - CHARLES I SON (CHARLES II) RETURNS FROM EXILE & BECOMES KING (1660):
 - RESTORATION OF EPISCOPACY
 - OPPRESSION OF PURITANS (BOTH PRESBYTERIANS & INDEPENDENTS)
 - RESISTED BY SCOT CONVENETERS & OTHERS
 - PERIOD OF PARADISE LOST & PILGRIM'S PROGRESS
 - PHILLIP II SUCCEEDS CHARLES II
 - ATTEMPTS RESTORATION TO CATHOLICISM
 - EXILED IN "GLORIUS REVOLUTION" (1688)

- □ WILLIAM & MARY ASCEND TO THRONE (1688):
 - ACT OF TOLERATION (1689):
 - EPISCOPAL CHURCH REMAINS NATL CHURCH OF ENGLAND
 - LIBERTY & LEGAL PROTECTION TO PURITANS
 - PRESBYTERIANS, INDEPENDENTS, BAPTISTS, & QUAKERS PROTECTED UNDER THE LAW

THE GERMAN PALATINATE:

- ONE OF SEVEN GERMAN ELECTORATES
- CAPITAL WAS HEIDELBERG (1231-1720)
- REFORMATION INTRODUCED BY ELECTOR FREDERICK II (1546):
 - HIGHLY INFLUENCED BY MELANCHTHON:
 - NATIVE OF THE PALATINATE
 - LUTHERANISM MORE FRIENDLY TO CALVINISM
 - REVISED AUGSBURG CONFESSION
- HEIDELBERG ATTRACTS PROTESTANT SCHOLARS:
 - BATTLEGROUND OVER THE REAL PRESENCE
 - BATTLE BETWEEN GENERAL SUPERINTENDENT HESHUSIUS & DEACON KLEBITZ
 - IMMEDIATE CAUSE FOR THE HEIDELBERG CATECHISM

- □ REFORMED PROTESTANTISM COMES TO THE PALATINATE:
 - FREDERICK III (THE PIOUS) BECOMES ELECTOR (1559)
 - OBJECT OF HIS REIGN TO CARRY OUT THE REFORMATION
 - DESIRED TO KNOW WHETHER REFORMED OR LUTHERAN VIEW WAS ACCURATE
 - ARRANGES PUBLIC DISPUTATION & FINDS IN FAVOR OF REFORMED VIEW
 - TASKS URSINUS & OLEVIANUS TO PREPARE THE HEIDELBERG CATECHISM
 - HEIDELBERG CATECHISM PUBLISHED (1563):
 - INITIALLY IN GERMAN; SOON TRANSLATED INTO ALL EUROPEAN & ASIATIC TONGUES:
 - MOST WIDELY CIRCULATED TEXT AFTER THE BIBLE, IMITATION OF CHRIST, & PILGRIM'S PROGRESS

CONTENT OF THE CATECHISM:

- THREE PARTS; FOLLOWING EPISTLE TO ROMANS:
 - SIN & MISERY OF MAN (QUES 3-11)
 - REDEMPTION BY CHRIST (QUES 12-85)
 - THE CHRISTIAN LIFE (QUES 86-129)

CATECHISM BRANCHES OUT BEFORE & DURING 30 YRS WAR:

- CATECHISM REVERED IN HOLLAND:
 - REACHES MANHATTEN ISLAND (1609)
 - FIRST PROTESTANT CATECHISM PLANTED ON AMERICAN SOIL
- CONTINUES AS CATECHISM FOR DUTCH & GERMAN REFORMED CHURCHES

- CATECHISM BRANCHES OUT BEFORE
 & DURING 30 YRS WAR (CONT):
 - PALATINATE RAVAGED DURING WAR (1618-48)
 - THOUSANDS OF PROTESTANTS EMIGRATED TO AMERICA & PLANTED CATECHISM IN PENNSYLVANIA
 - ALONG WITH WESTMINSTER & BELGIC CONFESSION, MOST NOTED CALVINISTIC CATECHISM IN USE TODAY
