- OVERVIEW OF LUTHER'S BEGINNINGS, ORIGINS OF HIS REFORMATION VIEWS, & EVENTS LEADING TO THE DIET OF WORMS IN AD 1521
- □ MARTIN LUTHER (1483-1546)
 - BORN IN EISLEBEN GERMANY--NOV 10, 1483
 - ELDEST OF SEVEN; STRICT PEASANT HOUSEHOLD IN COAL MINER TOWN
 - AT AGE 14, SENT TO FRANCISCAN SCHOOL AT MAGDEBURG
 - AT AGE 18, ENTERS UNIVERSITY OF ERFURT
 - ERFURT EMPHASIZED "OCKHAMIST" SCHOLASTICISM

□ LUTHER'S EARLY YEARS (CONT)

- · COMPLETES M.A. AT ERFURT-MAY, 1505
 - SUBSEQUENTLY BEGAN STUDIES TO BECOME A LAWYER
- JULY, 1505—STRUCK BY LIGHTNING
 - "HELP ME, ST ANNE, I WILL BECOME A MONK"
- ENTERS AUGUSTINIAN MONESTARY IN ERFURT
 - RIGID FASTING, PRAYER, & VIGIL
 - TORMENTED BY FITS OF ANFECHTUNGEN AND DEEP FEELINGS OF UNASSURANCE
 - STAUPITZ, VICAR GENERAL-DIRECTS LUTHER TOWARD THEOLOGICAL STUDY & SECRETS OF GRACE

□ LUTHER'S EARLY YEARS (CONT)

- AUGUSTINIAN MONESTARY IN ERFURT (CONT)
 - LUTHER PROVES HIS SCHOLARSHIP:
 - STUDIES SCHOLASTIC THEOLOGIANS (OCCAM, BIEL, D'AILLY, GERSON)
 - KNOWN FOR DILIGENCE AND SCHOLARSHIP
 - LUTHER SUMMONED TO TEACH THEOLOGY AT WITTENBERG (1508)

LUTHER AT WITTENBERG:

- INITIAL DUTIES--LECTURING ON PHILOSOPHY, NAMELY ARISTOTLE
 - CONVEYS THEOLOGICAL VICE PHILOSOPHICAL DESIRE
- AWARDED DOCTORATE OF DIVINITY (1512)

□ LUTHER AT WITTENBERG (CONT):

- BEGINS TEACHING THEOLOGY & PREACHING (1509)
 - "ERE LONG, LARGE AUDIENCES PAID HIM THE TRIBUTE OF EAGER ATTENTION"
- SENT TO ROME (1510-1511)
 - ENTHUSIASM FOR THE "HOLY CITY" TURNS COLD IN LIGHT OF ITS ABUSES
 - STILL PLAGUED BY ANFECHTUNGEN, ATTEMPTS TO ASCEND PILATE'S STAIRCASE ON HIS KNEES
- RETURNS TO WITTENBERG & BEGINS VISITATION OF OTHER AUGUSTINIAN MONESTARIES (1516)

□ LUTHER AT WITTENBERG (CONT):

- LIGHT BEGINS TO BREAK (1516-1517)
 - LUTHER BEGINS DILIGENT STUDY OF AUGUSTINE
 - LECTURES ON LETTER TO GALATIANS LEADS HIM TO ROMANS 1:17--"THE RIGHTEOUS SHALL LIVE BY FAITH"
 - LUTHER'S TRANSFORMATION MANIFESTED IN HIS TEACHINGS & WRITINGS

□ THE OUTER CONFLICT:

- AFTER THE CRUSADES, INDULGENCES WERE LARGE SOURCES OF REVENUE FOR ROME
- IN LUTHER'S TIME, INDULGENCES SUBSIDIZED BUILDING OF ST PETER'S CATHEDRAL

- IN 1517, JOHN TETZEL COMES TO AREA OF WITTENBERG
 - MASTER INDULGENCE-HAWKER:
 - "INDULGENCES ENTITLED YOU TO ABSOLUTION BY PRIEST OF CHOICE"
 - "INDULGENCES ENTITLED YOU TO 'MERITORIOUS WORKS OF THE UNIVERSAL CHURCH"
 - INDULGENCES ENTITLED YOU TO RELEASE OF SOULS IN PURGATORY
 - WHEN INDULGENCE-HOLDERS CAME TO LUTHER EXPECTING ABSOLUTION, LUTHER WAS HORRIFIED AT THEIR TRIVIALIZATION OF REPENTANCE
- OCT 31, 1517 -- LUTHER POSTS "95 THESES" ON DOOR OF CASTLE CHURCH OF WITTENBERG

- ESSENTIALS OF THE THESES:
 - GENUINE REPENTANCE IS THE CHIEF CONDITION OF THE REMISSION OF SINS
 - BELIEF THAT INDULGENCES CAN SECURE SALVATION OR RELEASE SOULS FROM PURGATORY IS A LIE
 - PENANCE SHOULD ONLY BE PLACED ON THE LIVING
 - ST PETER'S SHOULD BE REDUCED TO ASHES RATHER THAN BUILT BY "INDULGENCE EXTORTION"
 - POPE WOULD DO BETTER TO APPOINT ONE GOOD PASTOR TO A CHURCH THAN GIVE INDULGENCES TO THEM ALL

- REACTION TO THE THESES:
 - THESES REPRINTED & SPREAD THROUGHOUT GERMANY WITHIN WEEKS
 - ATTEMPTS AT REPUDIATION TYPICALLY RIDICULOUS
 - LEO X "A DRUNKEN GERMAN HAS WRITTEN THESE THESES AND WHEN HE SOBERS UP, HE WILL TALK VERY DIFFERENTLY"
 - ALTHOUGH NOT INITIALLY CONCERNED, LEO EVENTUALLY SUMMONS LUTHER TO ANSWER FOR "HERESY & CONTUMACY"
 - ORIGINALLY SUMMONED TO ROME, ELECTOR FREDRICK OBTAINS HEARING IN AUGSBURG GERMANY

- LUTHER AT AUGSBURG:
 - CALLED TO ACCOUNT BEFORE CARDINAL CAJETAN
 - TWO PIECES OF HERESY: DENIAL THAT TREASURE OF INDULGENCES IS EQUAL TO MERIT OF CHRIST AND DECLARATION THAT ONE WHO COMES TO THE SACRAMENT MUST EXERCISE FAITH TO THE EXTENT OF THE GRACE BENEFITED
 - LUTHER ATTEMPTS TO ARGUE FROM SCRIPTURE AND REFUSES TO RECANT
 - "SO LONG AS THESE AUTHORITIES STAND, I CANNOT DO OTHERWISE"
 - HOWEVER, ATTEMPTS TO BE CONCILIATORY:
 - NO MORE DISCUSSION OF INDULGENCES, IF SAME FOR THE OPPOSITION
 - APPEALED TO A GENERAL COUNCIL (1518)

- POST-AUGSBURG:
 - "TRUCE" IS ONLY TEMPORARY
 - DR ECK, CATHOLIC APOLOGIST, WRITES THESES AGAINST LUTHER'S POSITIONS
 - LUTHER FEELS REQUIRED TO RESPOND (DISPUTE AT LEIPZIG, 1519)
 - CARLSTADT VS ECK ON FREE WILL
 - LUTHER VS ECK ON PRIMACY OF POPE, PURGATORY, PENANCE, & INDULGENCES
 - LUTHER "I AM A HUSSITE" AND ALL FOLLOWERS ARE HUSSITES WITHOUT KNOWING IT
- FURTHER POSITIONS OF LUTHER:
 - FIVE TRACTS PUBLISHED IN 1520
 - SERMON ON GOOD WORKS
 - PAPACY AT ROME
 - ADDRESS TO THE GERMAN NOBILITY

- FURTHER POSITIONS OF LUTHER (CONT):
 - FIVE TRACTS (CONT)
 - BABYLONIAN CAPTIVITY OF THE CHURCH
 - FREEDOM OF THE CHRISTIAN MAN
- EVENTS LEADING TO WORMS:
 - PAPAL BULL REACHES WITTENBERG--OCT, 1520
 - CONDEMNS 41 OF LUTHER'S PROPOSITIONS
 - SIXTY DAYS TO RECANT OR BE EXCOMMUNICATED
 - LUTHER BURNS THE BULL & OTHER PAPAL DECREES DEC 10, 1520
 - LUTHER EXCOMMUNICATED-JAN 3, 1521

- EVENTS LEADING TO WORMS (CONT):
 - JAN, 1521 EMPEROR (CHARLES V) PRESIDES
 OVER DIET OF WORMS:
 - LUTHER SHOULD BE CALLED TO ACCOUNT FOR HIS CRIMES
 - ELECTOR FREDRIC GRUDGINGLY CONSENTS
 - · LUTHER PROVIDED 'SAFE CONDUCT' PLEDGE
- LUTHER AT WORMS (APRIL, 1521):
 - BOOKS SPREAD THROUGHOUT THE HALL:
 - "ARE THEY YOURS & WILL YOU RECANT?"
 - LUTHER REQUESTS ONE DAY TO CONSIDER
 - REFUSES TO RECANT UNLESS SCRIPTURAL PROOF OF ERRANCY OR 'PLAIN REASON' SHOWS THEM ERRANT:
 - · "HERE I STAND; I CAN DO NO OTHER"
