### ZWINGLI AND THE BEGINNINGS OF THE SWISS REFORMATION

- BACKGROUND OF THE SWISS REFORMATION:
  - AT TIME OF THE REFORMATION, SWITZERLAND CONSISTED OF 13 STATES OR CANTONS:
    - URI, SCWYTZ, UNTERWALDEN, LUCERN:
      - FOREST CANTONS (ROMANIST MAINSTAYS)
    - ZUG, SOLEURE, ZURICH, GLARUS, BERN, FREYBURG, BASEL, SCHAFFHAUSEN, & APPENZELL
    - SEPARATE FROM THE EMPIRE:
      - TREATY OF BASEL (1499)
    - SWISS NOTED FOR THEIR VALOR & SKILL IN BATTLE:
      - RESISTED THE HAPSBURGS (AUSTRIA)
      - RESISTED MAXIMILIAN'S INTRUSION
      - SUCCESS LED TO NOTORIETY AS MERCENARIES

#### ZWINGLI'S EARLY YEARS:

- ULRICH ZWINGLI BORN JAN 1, 1484 IN WILDHAUS
- · AS A YOUTH, STUDIES IN BASEL & BERN
- BEGINS UNIVERSITY WORK IN VIENNA
  - STUDIES SCHOLASTICISM
    - SOME HUMANIST INFLUENCE
  - OVERT PATRIOTISM DURING SWABIAN WAR
    - SENT AWAY IN 1499, BUT RETURNS AFTER 1500
- RECEIVES BACHELOR (1504) & MASTER OF ARTS (1506) AT BASEL
  - HIGHLY INFLUENCED BY HUMANIST THOMAS WYTTENBACH
- DUE TO UNCLE'S INFLUENCE, BECOMES PRIEST OF GLARUS (1506)

#### ZWINGLI'S EARLY PASTORATES:

- GLARUS (1506-1516):
  - ENTHUSIAST OF ERASMUS' WORK
  - OPPONENT OF MERCENARY ACTIVITY
- EINSIEDELN (1516-1519)
  - DEVOTES "WHOLE STRENGTH TO STUDY OF SCRIPTURE"
    - PREACHES "CHRIST ALONE SAVES"
    - APPRECIATION OF GREEK FROM ERASMUS
    - "BEFORE LUTHER WAS HEARD OF IN SWITZERLAND, I BEGAN TO PREACH THE GOSPEL"
  - OPPOSES INDULGENCE TRAFFIC
    - NOT AS DEFINING AN ISSUE TO ZWINGLI AS LUTHER
- ASSUMES PASTORATE OF "GREAT MINSTER" IN ZURICH (1519)
  - "THE WITTENBURG OF SWITZERLAND"

#### □ THE SIXTY-SEVEN CONCLUSIONS:

- ZWINGLI'S EQUIVALENT OF THE "95 THESES"
  - BROADER IN SCOPE, EMPHASIZING CHRIST AS ONLY SAVIOUR, SUPREMACY OF THE WORD, DENIAL OF PAPAL SUPREMACY, REJECTION OF THE MASS, FASTS, PILGRIMAGES, CELIBACY, & PURGATORY

### □ 3 PUBLIC DISPUTATIONS (1523-24):

- CALLED BY ZWINGLI TO SOLICIT ZURICH MAGISTRACY APPROVAL OF:
  - 67 CONCLUSIONS
  - ABOLITION OF MASS & IMAGES
- ZURICH MAGISTRATES UPHOLD ZWINGLI'S POSITIONS

#### REFORMATION IN ZURICH:

- REMOVAL OF ALL IMAGES, ORNAMENTS, PICTURES, RELICS, CRUCIFIXES, ALTARS, CANDLES IN 13 DAYS (1524)
  - BONES OF SAINTS BURIED
  - ORGAN REMOVED & MUSIC ABOLISHED
  - "THE ABSENCE OF IMAGES WILL INCREASE HUNGER FOR THE WORD"
- ABOLITION OF THE MASS:
  - REFORMED COMMUNION FIRST HELD IN 1525
    - FOUR TIMES ANNUALLY
- CHURCH SUBJUGATED TO THE MAGISTRACY:
  - DUTY OF THE MAGISTRACY TO OBEY THE GOSPEL, PROTECT RELIGION, PUNISH WICKEDNESS

### □ REFORMATION IN ZURICH (CONT):

- CHURCH SUBJUGATED TO THE MAGISTRACY (CONT):
  - DUTY OF THE PREACHER TO INSTRUCT, EXHORT, COMFORT, REBUKE SIN, & BUILD UP THE KINGDOM
    - BEGINNINGS OF SEPARATION; TO BE FOLLOWED IN GENEVA
    - CLEAR CIVIL ENFORCEMENT OF REFORMED POSITION VICE ROMANISTS & ANABAPTISTS

#### □ ANABAPTIST CONTROVERSY:

• ANABAPTIST POSITIONS REJECT INFANT BAPTISM, STATE ORDINANCES AFFECTING THE CHURCH, COLLECTION OF TITHES, & REQUIRE A "SINLESS CHURCH" (PERFECTIONISM)

### □ ANABAPTIST CONTROVERSY (CONT):

- ZWINGLI SYMPATHETIC TO SOME ANABAPTIST POSITIONS, BUT UNWILLING TO YIELD:
  - CONFERANCES OF MAGISTRATES IN JAN & NOV, 1525:
    - INFANT BAPTISM (8 DAYS) REQUIRED
    - MANDATE AGAINST REBAPTISM
  - ANABAPTISTS RESIST & SEVERAL ARE EXECUTED FOR "SUBVERSION"

### **EVENTS LEADING TO CAPPEL:**

- ZWINGLI SEEKS COMPLETE FREEDOM TO PREACH IN OTHER CANTONS
- "FOREST CANTONS" UNWILLING TO TOLERATE PROTESTANT TEACHING
  - JACOB KAISER BURNED AT STAKE (1529)

### □ EVENTS LEADING TO CAPPEL (CONT):

- ZURICH UNSUCCESSFULLY ATTEMPTS TO FORM DEFENSE LEAGUE:
  - ABILITY TO JOIN WITH GERMAN LUTHERANS (SMALCALD LEAGUE) FAILS
- "FOREST CANTONS" ATTACK ZURICH (OCT, 1531)
  - TROOPS MEET AT CAPPEL
  - ZURICHERS OUTNUMBERED 3:1 & OVERCOME
  - ZWINGLI SLAIN; BODY QUARTERED & BURNED
    - THEY MAY KILL THE BODY, BUT NOT THE SOUL
    - "WHATEVER MAY HAVE BEEN THY FAITH, THY WAS AN HONEST PATRIOT"

#### **EXTENSION OF SWISS REFORMATION:**

- BASEL (OECOLAMPADIUS)
- BERN
- CONTINUATION AT ZURICH (BULLINGER)

#### □ REFORMATION AT BASEL:

- JOHANN OECOLAMPADIUS (1482-1531):
  - GREATLY INFLUENCED BY HUMANISTS/REFORMERS:
    - REUCHLIN (HEBREW), WYTTENBACH, MELANCHTON AS A GERMAN UNIVERSITY STUDENT
    - AS PRIEST IN BASEL, ATTRACTED BY ERASMUS (RESIDENT)
    - FRIENDLY CONTACT WITH LUTHER
  - IN 1523, UNITES WITH ZWINGLIAN CAUSE

### □ REFORMATION AT BASEL (CONT):

- JOHANN OECOLAMPADIUS (CONT):
  - DEBATED ECK AT BADEN (1526)
  - INSPIRED REVOLT OF 1529 PARALLELING ZURICH CHANGES:
    - IMAGES DESTROYED
    - MASS ABOLISHED
  - MOST NOTED FOR CHURCH DISCIPLINE:
    - COLLEGE OF 12 CENSORS (PRESBYTERY) TO DEAL WITH SIN IN THE CHURCH
    - CENSORS COMPOSED OF PASTORS, MAGISTRATES, LAITY

#### □ REFORMATION AT BERN:

• SPAWNED BY THE "DISPUTATION OF BERN" (1528)

### □ REFORMATION AT BERN (CONT):

- THE "DISPUTATION OF BERN" (CONT)
  - BUCER (STRASSBURG REFORMER),
    OECOLAMPADIUS, ZWINGLI PREACH &
    DEBATE ROMANISTS
    - CLEAR VICTORY FOR REFORMERS
    - OF ZWINGLI "THIS BEAST IS MORE LEARNED THAN I THOUGHT"
  - TEN THESIS (CONCLUSIONS) OF BERN
- SUBSEQUENTLY, BERN ADOPTS ZWINGLIAN REFORMS
  - DISCONTINUATION OF THE MASS;
    ABOLITION OF IMAGES; ABOLITION OF
    CLERICAL CELIBACY & SEASONS OF
    FASTING; MANDATORY PREACHING AT
    LEAST FOUR DAYS A WEEK
- BERN--FUTURE HOME OF FAREL

### □ HEINRICH BULLINGER (1504-75):

- SUCCEEDED ZWINGLI AT ZURICH
  - CONTEMPORARY OF CALVIN IN GENEVA
    - STRONG RELATIONSHIP WITH GENEVA REFORMER
    - PROLIFIC WRITER (150 TITLES)
    - KNOWN FOR SHELTERING PROTESTANT REFUGEES
  - MOST NOTED FOR 2ND HELVETIC CONFESSION (1566):
    - · ADOPTED BY ALL SWISS CANTONS BUT 3
    - UNIFORMITY BETWEEN "FRENCH" & "GERMAN" SWISS REFORMERS
